Natalia Bychkova is a multi-faceted singing actress who performs early music, opera, and musical theater. She is an international opera singer who was born and raised in Russia and has sung in America, France, Italy, and Vienna. Most recently she sang in productions of “A My Name is Alice” and scenes from “Le Nozze di Figaro” and “Fiddler on the Roof” in Verona, Italy as part of the Opera Viva festival.



Last season, Ms. Bychkova performed excerpts from “Dialogues des Carmelites,” “Wolf-Ferrari’s Inquisitive Women,” and sang a world premiere of the new opera “Mondo Novo” at the Vienna Summer Music Festival. She also covered the principal role of Jael in the musical “In Pieces,” performed in the ensemble of “Silver Fox,” and served as a soloist and ensemble member of the Hildegard Ensemble.

As both soloist and ensemble member, Natalia Bychkova has participated in many memorable performances including Mozart’s Requiem with the West Village Chorale, Holst’s The Planets with the Greenwich Village Orchestra, and as part of the Gregorian Chant Project at St. John’s in the Village.

Favorite past roles include Zerlina in “Don Giovanni” in d’Hys, France, Despina in “Cosi fan Tutte,” and Eva in Dan Shore’s “An Embarrassing Position.”
